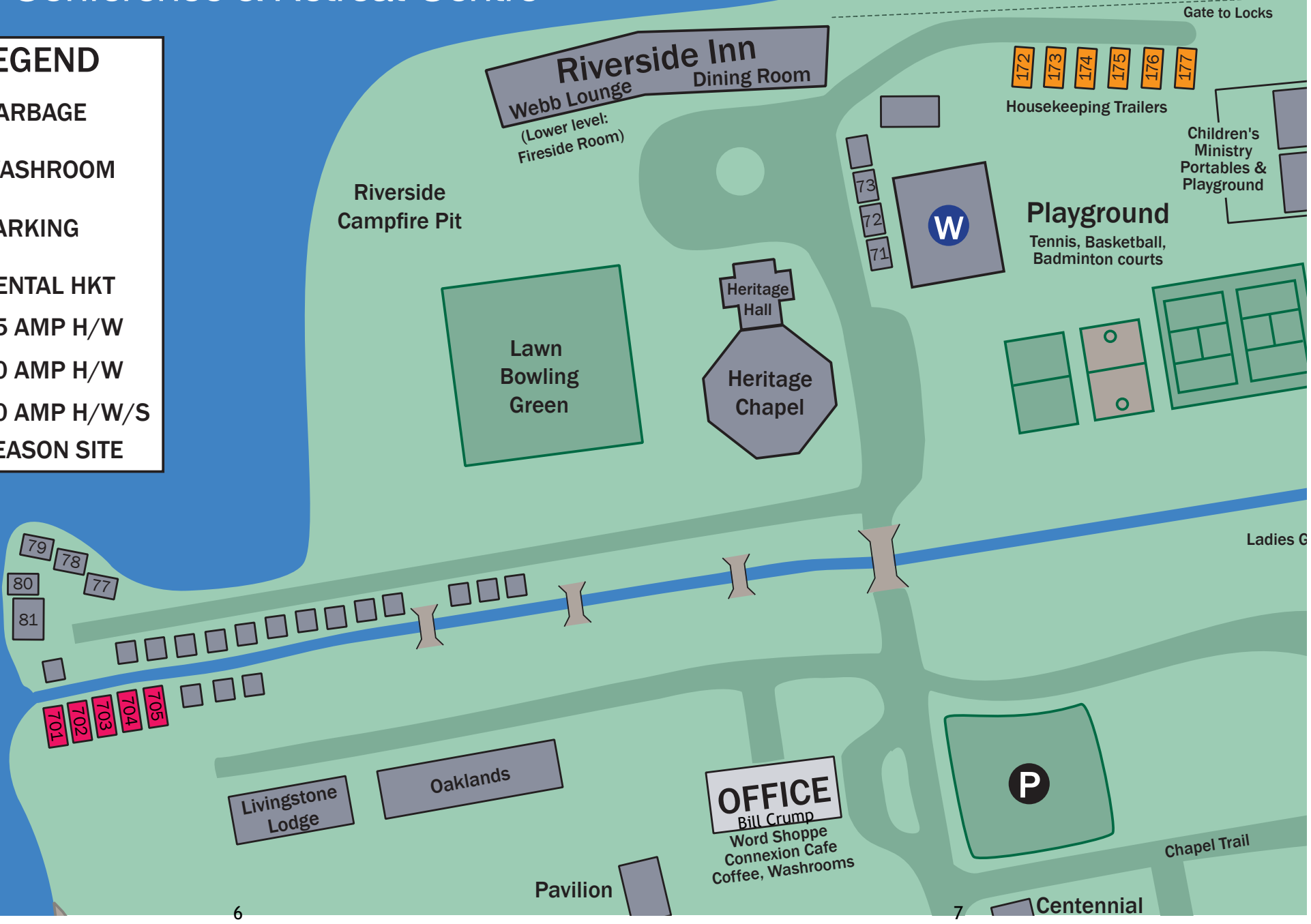

Session 1-Discernment

There are many distractions that will pull us away from God. There are four key voices that compete with the voice of God. They are the flesh, the world, people, and the adversary. So how do we test what we read, hear, think, or receive as we spend time with Jesus?

Two Hand Rule - ten fingers

A. Whose voice am I hearing?

1. Flesh - internal voice-thoughts and emotions
2. World - culture, tradition, TV, music, advertisements, technology, etc.
3. People - family, friends, peers, church, etc.
4. Adversary - Satan or demons
5. God

B. Content of message

1. Does not contradict the totality of Scripture
2. Aligns with God’s character
 - God’s voice is one of conviction and redemption not condemnation and judgement
3. Consolation (Brings Life) or Desolation (Brings Death)
 - Draw closer to God and others - comfort, assurance, affirmation, repentance, peace in your spirit
 - OR
 - Draws you away from the Lord or others - condemnation and judgment
4. Leads to truth/freedom/response
 - New or deeper truth
 - Set free from lies, fears, self-condemnation
 - Internal wrestle know that is what you are to do but wrestling with obedience
5. Body of Christ affirms
 - External confirmation by your community of faith
 - CAUTION - This one must agree with 1-4.

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Session 2-LECTIO DIVINA: HOLY READING

Lectio Divina: Holy Reading

Holy Reading is for the purpose of coming before the Word of God, to listen to God, to know God and to experience God.

Five Components:

Readiness/Preparation, Read, Reflect/Meditate, Respond, Rest

Process: *Begin by praying for the presence and protection of God.

1. Readiness/ Preparation

A. Come to silence held in God's presence

- Come as you are - be real and authentic before the Lord.
- Come expectant and believing that you will meet with God.

B. Create a place of silence - both physical and mental

- Be still - quiet mind, body, soul, and spirit.
- Pray and ask God to help you hear His voice and meet with Him.
- Be patient and wait upon the Lord (the Lord is at work even in the silence/waiting).
- Be open and receptive for whatever God brings - words (scripture/encouragement), feelings (peace, comfort), image and/or silence (knowing that you and Jesus are sitting in silence together not saying a word and enjoying one another's presence).

2. Read and listen to the Word of God

- Read **slowly** and **out loud** a short passage of Scripture several times and **listen** for a word or phrase that God brings to your attention
- Sit in silence for 2-3 minutes
- Ask "What is the word or phrase that God has brought to my attention?"

3. Reflect/meditate

- Re-read the passage again and ask, "How does this word or phrase touch my life?"
- Sit in silence for 2-3 minutes.
- Listen for what God is revealing through the word or phrase and reflect/meditate on how this touches your life or speaks to you.

4. Respond

- Re-read, listening for the invitation that is particular to your present experience.
- Sit in silence for 2-3 minutes.
- Ask "What is the invitation for me to respond?"/ "What is God inviting me to do in response to what I hear?"
- Respond in prayer, song, journal, etc.

5. Rest

- Sit in silence before God and experience His presence.
- Contemplate what God has given/revealed to you.
- Rest and just "be". To equip Christian Leaders for a Life of Wholeness and Holiness for the Freedom of Others.

PROCESS OF LECTIO DIVINA

Lectio Divina: Holy Reading - means sacred or devotional reading.

Lectio Divina is done purely and simply to come to know God, to be brought before the Holy Word, and to listen to God.

Process: *Begin by praying for the presence and protection of God.

1. LISTEN TO THE WORD OF GOD

Prepare by sitting in silence.

Read the passage *slowly* and *out loud* two or more times and listen for a word(s) or phrase that touches me or catches my attention.

Sit in silence and record what I heard.

2. ASK "HOW IS MY LIFE TOUCHED BY THIS WORD(S)/PHRASE?"

Read the passage again *slowly* and *out loud*.

Sit in silence and quietly meditate on "How the word(s) or phrase connects to my life?"

Record what I heard.

3. ASK "IS THERE AN INVITATION FOR ME TO RESPOND?"

Read the passage again *slowly* and *out loud*.

Sit in silence and quietly listen to God, "What is God inviting me to do in response to what I hear?"

Record what I heard.

4. PRAY

Read the passage again *slowly* and *out loud*.

Sit in silence and then respond in prayer.

5. REST

Read the passage again *slowly* and *out loud*.

Contemplate what God has given or revealed to you.

Rest and just "be".
